

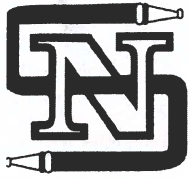
**Fire Tax Rate per \$100 Assessed Value \$10,543,207 3.25% \$ 342,654**

## RESOLUTION #2022-01 APPROVAL OF 2021-2022 ANNUAL BUDGET

A formal Resolution of the Governing Board of the Nogales Suburban Fire District (District) to adopt the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget of \$389,327.00 to encumber sufficient funds to cover outstanding items (purchase orders, checks, etc.), from the previous fiscal year, less any cash and liability reserves, and to encumber any carryover amount to offset taxes (less any unreimbursed stop/loss payments and any adjustments for uncollected out of District fire revenues incurred prior to June 30, 2021) establishing the balance to be utilized as our fiscal year end Reserved Fund Balance.

**WHEREAS**, Arizona Revised Statutes Title 48 requires the Nogales Suburban Fire District to adopt an annual budget and determine the compensation payable to District personnel; *and*


**WHEREAS**, a Public Hearing was held on the proposed 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget on July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, in compliance with State Law; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the District wishes to encumber any carryover amount to remain in the General Fund as our fiscal year end Reserved Fund Balance to be maintained to allow the Nogales Suburban Fire District to continue providing services to the community in case of economic downturns and/or unexpected emergencies or requirements, and to provide working capital in the first several months of the fiscal year, until sufficient revenues are available to fund operations.

**THEREFORE**, it is hereby resolved that the District's Governing Board adopts the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget of \$389,327.00, that encumbers sufficient funds to cover outstanding items (purchase orders, checks, etc.), any cash and liability reserves, and any carryover amounts to offset taxes (less any unreimbursed stop/loss payments and any adjustments for uncollected out of District fire revenues incurred prior to June 30, 2021) to remain in the General Fund as our fiscal year end Carry-Over Fund Balance.
