    - Discussion noted should a district become insolvent, they would need to consider merger
      or consolidation. NSFD is in this position and would probably need to be consolidated.
      Information and numbers need to be reviewed before recommendation of any action;
      however, the goal would be for RRMFD to absorb NSFD and become one district.
